## What we do:

- We have attended meetings at Lambeth Town Hall to ensure proper levels of budget for the park.
- We highlight park maintenance and gardening concerns to the Ruskin Park Manager for action.
- We continue to press for the completion of the bowling green replanting.
- We put pressure to ensure the children's paddling pool is opened each year.
- We are pushing forward plans for the old stable block to become a café and education centre.

## We use Members funds to:

- Buy new trees for the park, which Lambeth looks after
- Organise a series of events throughout the year for the local community to enjoy
- Hold quarterly public meetings that anyone can attend
- Release a quarterly newsletter, delivered or emailed to members and made available locally
